information with an "expert". Over the course of the study, the children will become "experts" themselves about the items in the class collection.

Throughout the study there will be time for children to share items they add to the class collection. They can present information they have about the item, including where they got it, what kind it is (if they know), and any other pertinent details. Children can keep special objects that they do not want to lose separate from the class collection. For very special objects, children can share them during a class meeting, put them out for observation at choice time, and take the home at the end of the day.
